Past-Tense Verbs

If the verb ends with a . . .

- silent final \mathbf{e} , drop the \mathbf{e} before $\mathbf{creat} \mathbf{e} \mathbf{e} + \mathbf{ed} = \mathbf{d}$ adding \mathbf{ed} .
- final single consonant following trip + p + ed = a short vowel, double the final tripped consonant before adding -ed
- y following a final consonant, change $apply y + i + \underline{ed} = b$ the y to i before adding $\underline{-ed}$. $appli\underline{ed}$
