## **Future-Perfect Tense**

- The **future-perfect tense** tells about an action that will be completed at a specific time in the future.
- By the time you arrive, we **will have waited** for an hour.
- The future perfect is formed with the helping verbs will have followed by either a main verb ending in <u>-ed</u> or a special form of the main verb.

By dinnertime, I <u>will</u> have completed my homework.

By Friday night, we will have chosen the winners.
